
Board Approves Proposed Final Budget

The Rose Tree Media School District Board of School Directors approved the Final Budget for the 2024-25 school year at its Legislative Meeting on Thursday, May 23.

The approved General Fund Budget outlines \$121,782,732 in expenses, with anticipated revenue of \$120,736,507 and a projected use of \$1,046,225 from the fund balance. This budget also includes a 3.5% tax increase.

The tax increase falls below the 5.3% index set by Act 1, a state-mandated limit on tax increases that governs the district's revenue through property taxes. Only 0.39% of the district's overall revenue is sourced from the federal government, while 82.6% is generated locally, largely from annual real estate taxes.
